One might assume that with a last name like his, Peter Law was destined to argue cases before the bench.

However, this was not the case for Law, who was working a construction job when his boss pulled him

aside. "He asked me what I was going to do with the rest of my life," recalled Law, who has an AV-rating from Martindale-Hubbell. "He suggested law school and it really hadn't crossed my mind, but after some thought, I decided I would go."

In 1993, Law earned his JD from Emory University School of Law—where he claims he was singled out by all of his professors due to his convenient surname—and started defending injury cases for Drew, Eckel & Farnham. Two years later, he launched his own practice and started doing plaintiff's personal injury work exclusively.

Law's experience representing clients from both sides of the courtroom gives him a certain advantageous edge "as far as the organization and structure of a case goes," explains Law. "I was trained on how insurance companies operate and how defense lawyers think about a case, and that has helped tremendously."

According to Law, he considers it his life's work to give people their lives back, and he's surrounded himself with lawyers who help him to that end. "We're able to give some future and normalcy to our clients' lives," says Law, who is married with five children. "We really do help people get back on their feet and move past tragic incidents."
